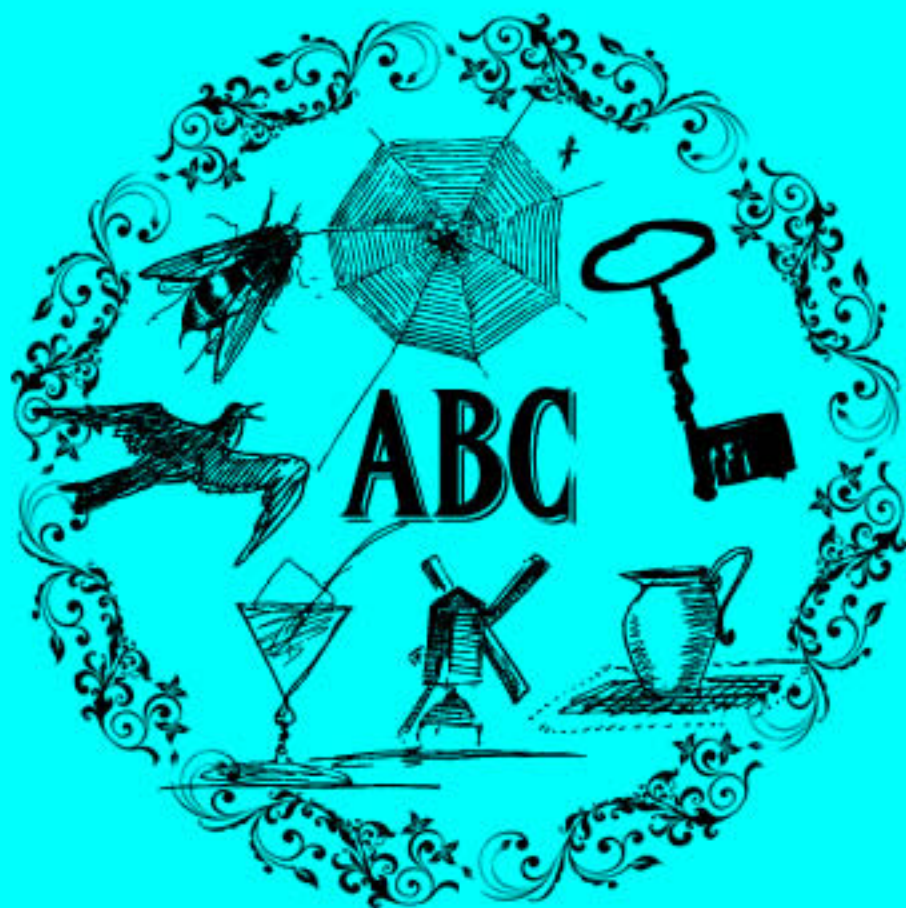

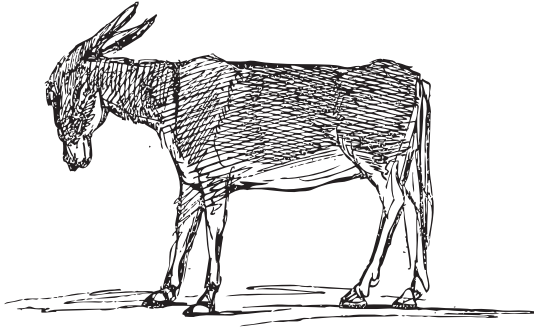

Which caused him to bray.

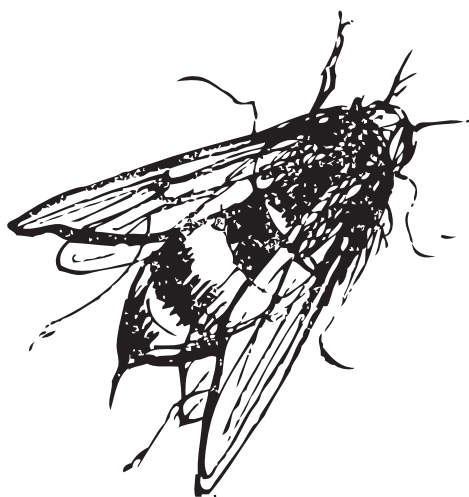
**a!**

On a dark night.

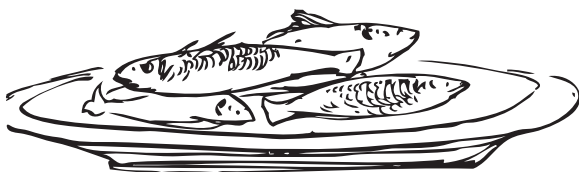
**c!**

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**E**



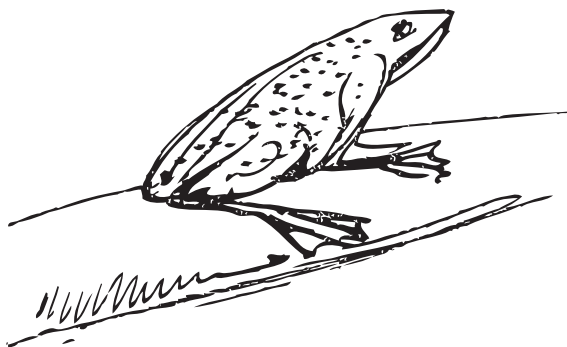
**E** was an Eagle,

As if he were choking.

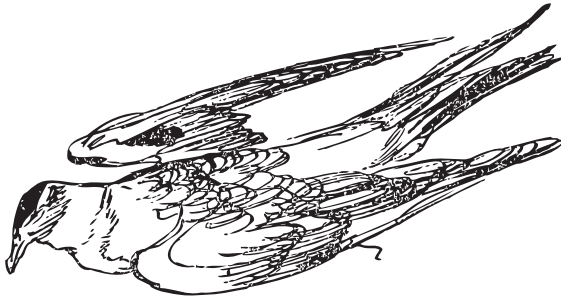

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**H**

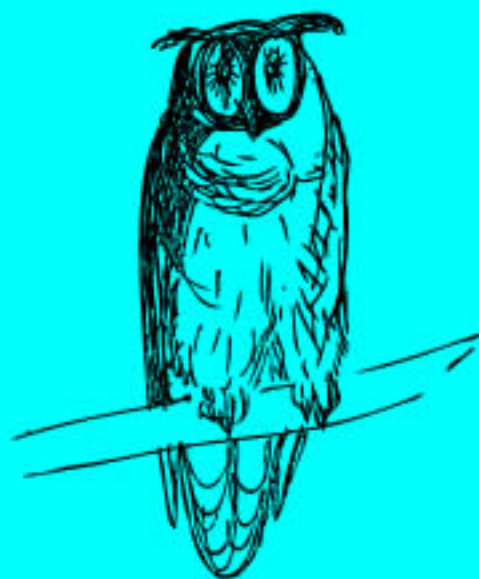
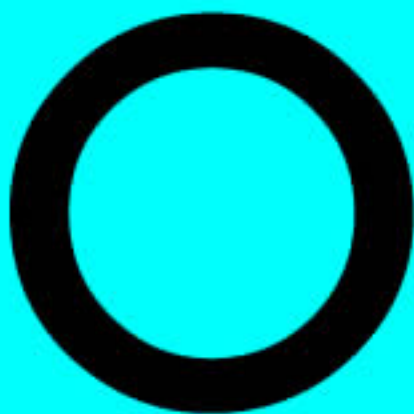


**H** was a Hat,
